**Shichi-go-san 七五三**  
 Shichi-go-san, is an event that takes place on November 15 for boys turning 3 and 5 years old, and girls turning 3 and 7 years old. Families visit nearby Shinto shrines to pray for their children's health and growth. Girls dress up in *Kimono* and boys in *Haori* and *Hakama*, and it is a tradition to enjoy the celebration with *Chitose-ame* - special candy for this event.
