Tanabata, Star Festival is held on July 7 in most parts of Japan or August 7 in some areas. Based on a Chinese folk legend in which two stars - Altair (Cowherd) and Vega (Weaver) - love each other but only allowed to cross the Milky Way to meet once a year on this day.  
Wishes are written on long colored strips of paper and hung from a bamboo branch with other decorations.
