The blue wings were sparkling and beautiful in the light of the sun that spilled from the gap of a tree. In odashirobara marshland, you can see such a miraculous sight.

In the afternoon in odashirogahara marshland, the "Lady of odashirogahara", the birch tree was shining from the sunlight, stood out for its whiteness, and the beauty of the moment captivated the people who were there.

Golden glow (Rudbeckia laciniata)

This yellow flowers that bloom in summer are actually an invasive species. But you can see domestic species "Aleutian ragwort (*Senecio cannabifolius less*)" in Okunikko. In Okunikko, the diversity of plants are rich. It would be fun to observe this difference.

●At Nikko Botanical Garden, Ginryo-modoki(*Monotropa uniflora*) and Kirengeshoma *palmata* will be bloom soon.
