The grass was changing color little by little in Odashirogahara marshland, and the leaves of *Prunus ssiori* (*Shiuri-zakura*) around Lake Yunoko began to dye red. In Okunikko, signs of change to autumn have been confirmed in some places.

◆ Precautions for Hikers

- **Lake Sainoko**...The water in the Lake Sainoko increased due to the heavy rain, and the lake was full of water. If you plan to hike there, be careful after the rain because there is mud in some places.
- **Senjogahara marshland**...There are large gap between the steps on the stairs of a part of wooden footpath of Senjogahara marshland for renovation.
- **Lake Chuzenji** ...The Lake Chuzenji of Nangan line(Azegata ⇄ Senjugahama) is closed due to construction.
