The temperature was slightly higher in late August rather than usual, but cherry blossoms, Japanese Rowan (Nanakamado), Willowleaf Meadowsweet (Hozaki-shimotsuke) and Geranium yesoemse var. nipponicum (Hakusan-fuuro) are beginning to turn red.

● Flower

◆ *Cimicifuga simplex* (Sarasina-shouma)

Near the Izumiyadoike Pond, Kamchatka bugbane (Sarasina-shouma) bloom. If you find the flower, please try to smell it. It has slight sweet sent!

◆ Precautions for Hikers

Due to the persistent rain in middle August, the detour between Yudaki Falls and the Izumiyadoike Pond is badly muddy.
