● Feeling Fall

◆ Lake Chuzenji and Irohazaka Slope

The fading of autumn leaves rapidly advanced and you should look forward to next year's leaves.

◆ Around Lake Yunoko and Nikko Futarasan-jinja Chugushi

While the autumn leaves there are still vivid, but the end is near as the leaves are beginning to fall.

◆ Larch trees (Karamatsu) known as the "Golden Folding Screen" in Odashirogahara marshland, Senjogahara marshland and Lake Yunoko

Although the peak of the best season has passed, yellow leaves can still be seen. This is likely the last leaves to be seen in Okunikko this autumn.

◆ City of Nikko (Nikko Toshogu Shrine, Nikkosan Rinnōji, Nikko Futarasan-jinja Shrine)
