◆ Animals for Animals preparing for New Year's Eve

Animals starting to winter in Okunikko. In the Yutaki parking lot, Japanese macaques (Nihon-zaru) eat fruits, and they do not hibernate they need to store food before it runs out. In addition the Eurasian coot (Ooban), a winter bird, comes again to Lake Yunoko this year. When you look at these birds, you can feel the coming of winter.
