The early summer-like weather at the beginning of this week affected Okunikko as well, and the Akayashio flowers and Oyama-zakura cherry trees are now at their best.

◆ Green Slow Mobility : Electric low-speed vehicles

Electric low-speed vehicles "Green Slow Mobility" started operation on April 27th. It is gathering attentions as connecting transportation between the World Heritage Sites and Nishimachi area, a gate town spreading to the west of World Heritage Site which is difficult for large buses to access. Adults: 150 yen per ride.

◆ Others

The Konsei Road (R120), which had been closed for the winter season, is now open.

However, the lowest temperature is forecasted to be below zero in Yumoto during GW, so be careful when driving.

Mt. Nantai has been opened to climbers from April 25th, and the trails around the Lake Yunoko was fully opened.
