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● Nature

The autumn leaves in Okunikko have passed their peak, and the larch trees that color late autumn are shining golden in the sunlight. Although the leaves at Lake Sainoko are in the process of falling, the forest road leading to the lake is beautiful with the soft sunlight shining through the yellow larch leaves.

Around Yumoto area, the temperature sometimes drops below zero in the morning and evening. The fantastic sight of steam fog rising from the surface of Lake Yunoko in the early morning is often seen these days. The increasing number of ducks, such as the yellow-winged teal and the white-winged teal, indicate that winter season is coming.

You can enjoy autumn leaves at its best below 1,000m area. The most beautiful colors can be seen at Kirifuri Waterfall. Also, the colors are at their best around World Heritage area, Tamozawa Imperial Villa, and the Nikko Botanical Garden, with the surrounding mountainsides turning beautiful colors.
