○Cost: Pre-event: 1,700 yen

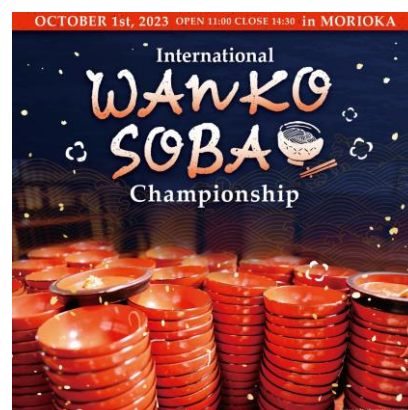
Wanko soba competition: 2,200 yen
