Kurinsou (Primula japonica) at Senjugahama Beach has been splendidly growing up since last week. Best time to see it. At Senjogahara Marshland and Odashirogahara Marshland, Zumi (Malus toringo) has past its prime period, whereas Watasuge (Eriophorum vaginatum) runs riot there instead. It's also the best time to see Shiurizakura (Padus ssiori) and Rengetsutsuji (Rhododendron japonicum) at Yumoto Onsen.
