● Nature

On October 10th, the lowest temperature at Senjogahara marshland was 0.8°C, and the first frost and the first ice were observed. Due to the rapid cooling of the temperature from the beginning of the week, we expected to see an increase in the color of the autumn leaves, but as of October 12th, we did not see any significant progress. The area around Lake Yunoko was probably the most autumn-like scenery.

A young male deer was next to the Okunikko Konishi Hotel with a doe. We had never seen a stag in the Yumoto area in the summer, so considering the season, it was probably a harem. It is said that they become rough during the breeding season, so we need to be careful about the distance between us and them.
