Most of the larch trees in Okunikko have lost their leaves, and the autumn colors at Lake Chuzenji are just about over. Kuma-dana (arboreal feeding signs by Asian black bears), which were made in early autumn, stand out conspicuously in the leafless forest. This year, there seems to be many of them.

Currently, autumn leaves has turned brilliant colors in the World Heritage area, and many people were enjoying taking pictures with those trees. Autumn leaves in the Nikko Botanical Garden and the Tamozawa Imperial Villa Memorial Park are also at their best.
