- ① Obtain your free stamp booklet at Narita Airport, Haneda Airport, any JR EAST Travel Service Centers within stations with the Yamanote Line, or at JAPAN RAIL CAFE TOKYO (Tokyo Station).
- ② Collect station stamps from three designated stations in the stamp booklet.
