The governors of the seven Kyushu prefectures will perform a traditional sake barrel-breaking ceremony. (September 3, 11:15 AM-11:45 AM)

(2) Exhibition Booths from Each Prefecture

Each Kyushu prefecture will showcase its unique characteristics through interactive booths. Visitors can immerse themselves in each prefecture's food, culture, nature, and more.

(3) Food booths (See attachment 1)

Exclusive to the Expo, the "Kyushu Treasure Bento(Lunch box)" featuring ingredients from across Kyushu will be on sale. We will also offer a selection of alcoholic beverages and soft drinks from the region.

(4) Live event (*See attachment 2*)

Enjoy a stage performance infused with Kyushu's traditions and charm. This fun and exciting event is designed for the enjoyment of all ages, from children to adults.

(5) Exhibition tour

After touring the exhibition, which will take you around the booths of each prefecture, eligible visitors will be able to enjoy a free "Marutai Bou Ramen" (local noodles).
