

Over 10 Million Visitors Since Opening — About 5 Million Are International Tourists

On October 12, 2025, <u>teamLab Planets TOKYO DMM.com</u> (hereinafter referred to as teamLab Planets), located in Toyosu, Tokyo, welcomed over 10 million visitors from more than 211 countries and regions since its opening on July 7, 2018 (1).

Among these visitors, approximately 5 million were international tourists. Guests from countries such as the United States, Australia, China, Hong Kong, Canada, the United Kingdom, and Germany have traveled from afar to visit the museum. Over 70% of foreign visitors purchased their tickets prior to arrival in Japan, indicating a trend of travelers visiting Tokyo with teamLab Planets as one of their main travel purposes (2).
