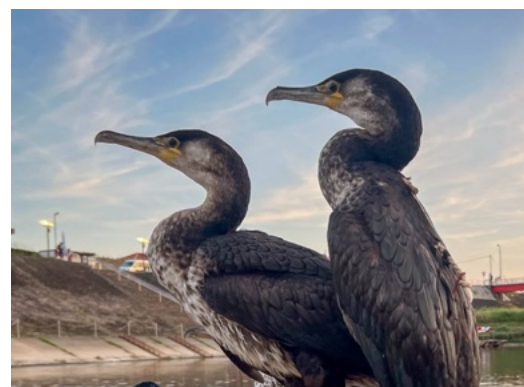
[Explore Miyoshi, Hiroshima this summer! Miyoshi Adventure Tour](#)

Cormorant Fishing

Miyoshi is one of only 11 locations preserving the fascinating practice of cormorant fishing. In Miyoshi, this 450-year-old tradition continues to be practiced for summer nighttime sightseeing. Meet the fisherman, learn about the birds' lives, and witness their remarkable teamwork under lantern-lit skies as you enjoy dinner on the river.

Gōno River Adventure

The Gōno River winds through Miyoshi, shaping both its landscape and lifestyle. Spend a full day immersed in nature with hands-on lure fishing, a riverside lunch, and a 12 km rafting journey featuring calm stretches and gentle rapids, making it ideal for both beginners and active travelers. Relax in the Mori No Izumi Kimita Onsen after a full day of river fun.



Mountains & Monsters

Hike up Higumayama to see the cursed rock, a focal point of a local legend about yōkai, the mysterious spirits that Japan. At the Miyoshi Mononoke Museum, dive into Japan's rich folklore through immersive exhibits dedicated to these legendary creatures. It's a must-visit for anyone curious about the cultural imagination of rural Japan.

Finish the tour with a thoughtfully prepared course meal at Mansabō, highlighting local flavors and seasonal ingredients. The tour is ideal for those who enjoy light physical activity, cultural immersion, and unique local experiences. Expect to get a little wet, walk scenic trails, and discover the adventure that Miyoshi has to offer.
