Explore Kurobe Gorge in Autumn with Eligible JR Passes

ABOUT KUROBE GORGE RAILWAY

Kurobe Gorge, located in Chubusangaku National Park in central Japan, is the deepest gorge in Japan and one of the country's three great gorges. The Kurobe Gorge Railway runs along this dramatic landscape. Known affectionately as the "Trolley Train," its open-sided passenger cars let visitors experience the wind sweeping through the gorge, the sound of the Kurobe River, and the scent of the forest up close. This popular sightseeing railway welcomes approximately 600,000 passengers from Japan and overseas each year. Autumn is especially popular: differences in elevation create a gradation of color from the mountaintops to the river. The approximately 20 km journey from Unazuki Station to Keyakidaira Station takes about 80 minutes round trip. Unazuki, home to the railway's departure station, is also one of Japan's best-known hot-spring resorts, making it an ideal companion to the trolley-train experience.

Full service between Unazuki and Keyakidaira resumes on October 1, 2026, for the first time in approximately two and a half years.

Following damage to a railway bridge caused by the January 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake, trains had been operating only as far as Nekomata Station. Restoration work is now complete, and full service to Keyakidaira Station will resume on October 1, 2026.

CAMPAIGN DETAILS

- Campaign period: April 20-November 30, 2026 (final day of 2026 operations)
- Present an eligible JR Pass at the Unazuki Station ticket counter to receive 10% off one round-trip ticket for one person per pass. (Round-trip tickets between Unazuki and Kuronagi are not eligible.)
- Valid only for same-day tickets. Advance reservations are not eligible.
- An additional charge of JPY 600 each way applies when traveling in a Relax Car.
- If your preferred train is full, you will be offered the next available service.
