New Illumination “The Starlight Million”

November 6, 2026 – February 25, 2027

Huis Ten Bosch, a theme park resort in Nagasaki Prefecture built around the brand promise “Step into the extraordinary,” will unveil its all-new illumination, “The Starlight Million,” on November 6, 2026 (Friday). The illumination, which has been recognized as Japan’s No. 1 for 13 consecutive years* 1, will undergo its first major renewal in 16 years.

The illumination transforms the park into a dazzling starry world, with countless stars scattered across windowsills, cobblestone streets, and the tree-lined avenues surrounding the plazas, creating an enchanting experience that makes guests feel as though they are walking beneath a sky filled with twinkling stars.

In this release, we introduce “The Starlight Million,” a meticulously crafted world and immersive space created with the pride of being recognized as Japan’s No. 1 illumination, bringing guests an unprecedented level of beauty and wonder through light.

Step into a town enveloped in the glow of countless stars, where a fantastical illumination makes you feel as though you're walking through the night sky. At Christmas, twinkling stars join the spectacle, transforming the town into its most dazzling yet.

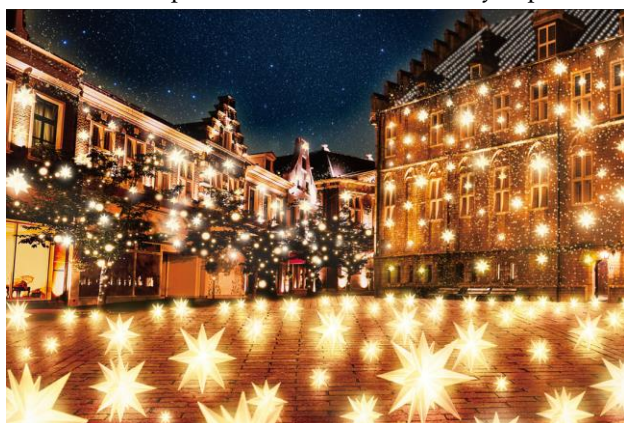
“The Starlight Million” is a fantastical illumination experience where the European streetscapes come alive in harmony with twinkling stars, each carrying a heartfelt wish.

Amsterdam City, located at the heart of the park, transforms into a plaza where starlight races across the space, with more than 100 star-shaped objects illuminating building facades and the ground below. The stars flicker as if alive, inviting guests to touch them and experience the sensation of wearing their light.

A moon-shaped object large enough to sit on also makes its debut, along with captivating effects incorporating smoke and the waterfront. Thousands of sparkling lights spread across the area on a breathtaking scale, seemingly filling the entire night sky. With the twinkling stars within arm’s reach, guests can immerse themselves in an enchanting experience that feels like walking through a star-filled sky.

The tree-lined promenade along the canal is also adorned with sparkling star illuminations, with an enchanting trail of light guiding guests toward Amsterdam City. The trees are brought to life with an immersive display that evokes stars descending from the night sky, gathering on the branches and twinkling as they seem to spill from the treetops. Stretching for 500 meters, the entire canal is transformed into a breathtaking sea of dazzling light. Beyond Amsterdam City, the approximately 66-meter-wide “Waterfall of Light” and “Aurora Garden of Light” will also receive exciting updates. Throughout the park, guests can immerse themselves in a fantastical world where countless stars seem to cascade from the night sky. In addition, the Christmas event will return on its largest scale ever*2, creating a magical winter world where the twinkling stars of “The Starlight Million” blend seamlessly with the festive Christmas atmosphere. Together, they create an enchanting experience unique to the winter season. Throughout the event, the streetscapes of Amsterdam City will be adorned in festive splendor from every angle, with wreaths, ribbons, and dazzling lights. The one-of-a-kind “Grand Chandelier Tree,” the only one of its kind in Japan*3, will also make its appearance, shimmering with approximately 9,000 crystals. Enveloped in layers of starlight from “The Starlight Million,” the radiant Christmas setting creates an extraordinary experience unlike any before.
